General Info:

- Campers must pre-register! When deciding which camp session your child should attend, we recommend the grade level he/she will be entering next school year.
- Registration price covers camp picture, t-shirt, and snack shack.
- Scholarships are available for campers who have a financial need. Contact info@campunion.org for consideration.
- For the safety and protection of our campers and staff, we are not allowing visitors this year.
- Campers MUST check in at the Camp Office when they arrive at camp BEFORE moving into the dorms to complete registration.
- Camp Dismissal: No Family Services this year. Campers will be dismissed between 5:00-6:00pm on the final day of each session.
- Permission to leave the ground MUST be obtained from directors.
- Participation will be required in most activities.
- Our Dress Code is to practice Christian modesty!
 - No tank tops, halter tops, midriff shirts, or bare shoulders.
 - Only modest shorts will be allowed.
 - For ladies, swimsuits must be conservative one-piece suits or worn with a cover-up.
 - Sandals are permitted, however, tennis shoes & socks are required for some activities.
 - The directors reserve the right to have campers change clothes if what they're wearing is deemed inappropriate.

What to bring:

- Sleeping Bag/Bedding & Pillow
- Towels, Soap, Shampoo & Deodorant
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Clothes for each day
- Swimsuit (one piece)
- Jacket, Sweatshirt, Jeans (evenings can be chilly)
- Bug Spray & Sunscreen
- Tennis shoes & Socks
- Sandals/flip flops for water games
- Bible (NIV preferred)
- Prescription medications (in original bottles & clearly labeled. All medications will be given to camp nurse or directors at registration.

What to NOT to bring:

- Electronic Games/Devices
- Tobacco, alcohol, drugs
- Pop, snacks, candy
- Cell phones- use this opportunity to "unplug" for a week! Phones will be available for use in case of an emergency.
